



# What you should know about **FIREWORKS SAFETY** In DuPont

**Q: WHEN CAN I LIGHT OFF FIREWORKS IN DUPONT?**

**A: The DuPont Municipal Code (DMC) 9.12.020(a) states that fireworks are permitted within the city limits for two (2) days a year:**

**July 3—12 noon through 12 midnight**

**July 4—12 noon through 12 midnight**



**Q: CAN I LIGHT MY FIREWORKS IN THE STREET IN FRONT OF MY HOUSE?**

**A: Fireworks are not permitted on public property such as (but not limited to) city streets, sidewalks and public parks - DMC 9.12.020(b).**

**Q: WHAT KIND OF FIREWORKS CAN I USE?**

**A: You can refer to the list of approved and illegal fireworks we've provided for you, courtesy of the Fire Protection Bureau of the Washington State Patrol, or visit their website <http://www.wsp.wa.gov/fireworks/> (under *General Fireworks information*) for a more detailed view.**

## **LEGAL FIREWORKS INCLUDE:**

Cylindrical Fountains, Helicopters/Aerial Spinners, Cone Fountain, Smoke Devices, Roman Candles, Parachutes, Wheels, Mine/Shells/Cakes, Ground Spinners, Reloadable Mortars, Dipped Stick, Sparklers and Novelties

## **BANNED/ILLEGAL FIREWORKS AND EXPLOSIVE DEVICES:**

Firecrackers, Sky Rockets and Missiles, Bottle Rockets, M-80's, M-100's, etc., Improvised/Homemade Explosive Devices (aka, IEDs) and Altered Fireworks

*PLEASE BE CAREFUL WHEN USING FIREWORKS, AS THEY CAN CAUSE SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY AND DAMAGE TO YOUR OWN AND OTHERS' PROPERTY. BE KIND TO YOUR NEIGHBORS AND CLEAN UP YOUR DEBRIS.*
