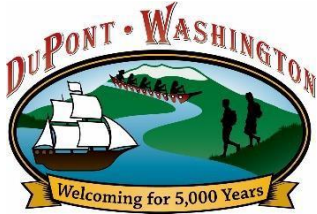
Criteria
