our water clean.



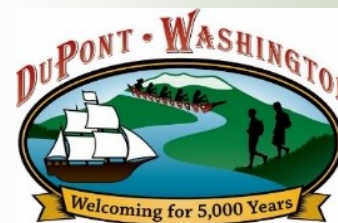
### Report Violators

## CAR WASHING

## When You Wash Your Car at Home, Where Does Soapy Water Go?

Water rinsed off a car contains a mixture of detergents, oils, and heavy metals that flow onto the street, into streams, and Puget Sound untreated. There are two types of pollutants generated by car washing on paved areas:

- 1) pollution associated with the use of soap, and
- 2) automobile-related pollutants that bind with the soap.



## Eco-Friendly Home Car Wash



If you wash your car at home...

- Wash it on the lawn or gravel where water can soak into and get filtered by the soil.
- Use a hose with an adjustable nozzle.
- "Biodegradable" only means that the soap will break down over time. It is preferable to use a biodegradable soap, but it doesn't guarantee it is better for plants, animals, and the environment.
- Look for soaps that are:
  - \*Non-toxic
  - \*Biodegradable
  - \*Phosphate-free
  - \*Vegetable or citrus-based
- Avoid soaps with label reading Caution, Danger, or Warning.
- After washing, dispose of the bucket contents into the sewer system, such as toilets and sinks.
